The “BIG PICTURE” of Abraham section [Five themes in Abraham](#)

1. Justification by *Faith*, not works (Gen 12:1-5 & Gen. 15:1-6 today’s Abraham 1-lesson)
2. Covenant Gen 15:7-21
3. Resurrection Faith Genesis 22:1-14 (Abe Isaac sacrifice) Abraham 2 - lesson
4. The nations will be blessed in Abraham’s “seed” Genesis 22:15-18
 Jacob’s story: Gen 27:1 – 41 steals Esau’s blessing, tricks his father
 Gen 32:1-32 Jacob wrestles with God, limp, then meets Esau Abraham 3 - lesson
5. God places His people strategically to move His salvation plan forward – the story of Joseph
 Genesis 37-50 Abraham – 4 lesson

REMINDER:

Observe: before interpreting/applying, take time to simply make observations, like a child exclaiming with wonder, or a detective pointing out clues, or a scientist listing data, or a lover appreciating their beloved. What do you observe? Always observe: Who, What, Where, When. Notice repeated things, what are key words, what prompts a question in your mind?

Interpret: compare, contrast, connect, context, outline, headline, underline, dig

Apply: Truth to be glad of, error to avoid, example to follow, mystery to ponder
